PRAYERS TO PRAY FOR THE LOST

Pray that God would draw their hearts unto himself.

DO

Share your story, let them know how you came to faith. Then ask them if they have a story, or if they would like to have one.

Ask people what their world view is or what their thoughts about God are. You'll likely have an open door to share yours.

OPEN DOORS

Ask God for opportunities to share your faith!

If you start your day praying a prayer like that God will surely answer it! Whether it's at work, the gym, your doctor's office, a bank, a store, a restaurant, a sporting event, the beach, or wherever.

Just ask God for open doors to share and you'll see door after door open wide!

REFLECTION

A goal I have is to share my faith at least once a day. Set your own goal. How many times would you like to share your faith each week?

Where are the places you go on a daily/weekly basis?

YOUR

Invite people to church.

Although I personally feel this is the second step rather than the first, I recognize this is a valid way for people to come to faith so invite folks to our traditional service, our contemporary service and our new modern service. Invite away!

COURAGE

Ask God for courage to share your faith! He is going to open the doors so make sure to ask him for the courage to walk through those doors when he opens them!

He'll often remind you of others sharing their faith or scriptures like 2 Timothy 1:7 or Joshua 1:9. Just remember if you ask for courage you will surely receive it! (Matthew 7:7)

REFLECTION

Who are the people you usually see in those places that you can share your faith with?

PART

Ask people if they need prayer for anything.

Depending on their response, you'll know if there's an open door to pray and share your faith.

WISDOM

Ask God for wisdom as you share your faith! Each person is different so although it's good to have an idea of what you might say invite God's wisdom to guide you.

He promises in Proverbs 3:5-6 that He will lead you, and when you don't know what to say he promises to give you the words! (Luke 12:12)
